Announcer: CHUCK SCHUMER AND THOSE WHO DON'T WANT AMERICANS TO OWN FIREARMS ARE AT IT AGAIN.

FORTUNATELY, THERE IS A BILL IN THE UNITED STATES SENATE THAT WOULD STOP CHUCK SCHUMER AND THOSE OPPOSED TO FIREARM OWNERSHIP IN THEIR TRACKS. S. 659, THE PROTECTION OF LAWFUL COMMERCE IN ARMS ACT, BLOCKS THESE RECKLESS LAWSUITS, AND PROTECTS LAWFUL AMERICAN FIREARMS COMPANIES FROM BEING SUED FOR THE ACTS OF CRIMINALS.

THE WHITE HOUSE SUPPORTS THIS BILL, AND THE U.S. HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES HAS ALREADY PASSED IT BY A VOTE OF BETTER THAN TWO TO ONE.

SO WHERE DOES SENATOR JOHN MCCAIN STAND ON THIS IMPORTANT BILL? HE ISN'T SAYING.

MAYBE HE THINKS OUR MEN AND WOMEN IN UNIFORM SHOULD HAVE TO BUY THEIR WEAPONS FROM FOREIGN COMPANIES.
